Key components include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Systematic learning of traditional Chinese sports culture, focusing on classic practices such as Five-Step Boxing (Wubu Quan) and Baduanjin Qigong. ● In-depth experience of intangible cultural heritage (ICH) martial arts, with visits to inheritance bases for Meihua Quan and Tanglang Quan (Mantis Boxing). ● A platform for cultural exchange between Chinese and foreign participants to promote interaction, mutual learning and mutual appreciation of sports cultures. ● Cutting-edge seminars on sports disciplines, covering hot topics including innovative physical education and development of physical fitness training, with discussions led by Chinese and international experts.
