
VERBAL NOTE

The Intensive Programme in European Law and Economics (hereinafter – the Programme), annually organized by the Riga Graduate School of Law, implemented with the financial support of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Latvia and the U.S. Department of State, will take place from 11 November to 20 December 2024.

The Programme is designed for professionals from the European Neighbourhood, Central Asia and the Western Balkans. Over a period of 6 weeks, the Programme provides comprehensive training on the legal, economic and political work of the European Union. The Programme also includes a study visit to Brussels for in-person meetings in the European Parliament, the European Commission, the European External Action Service and other EU institutions.
